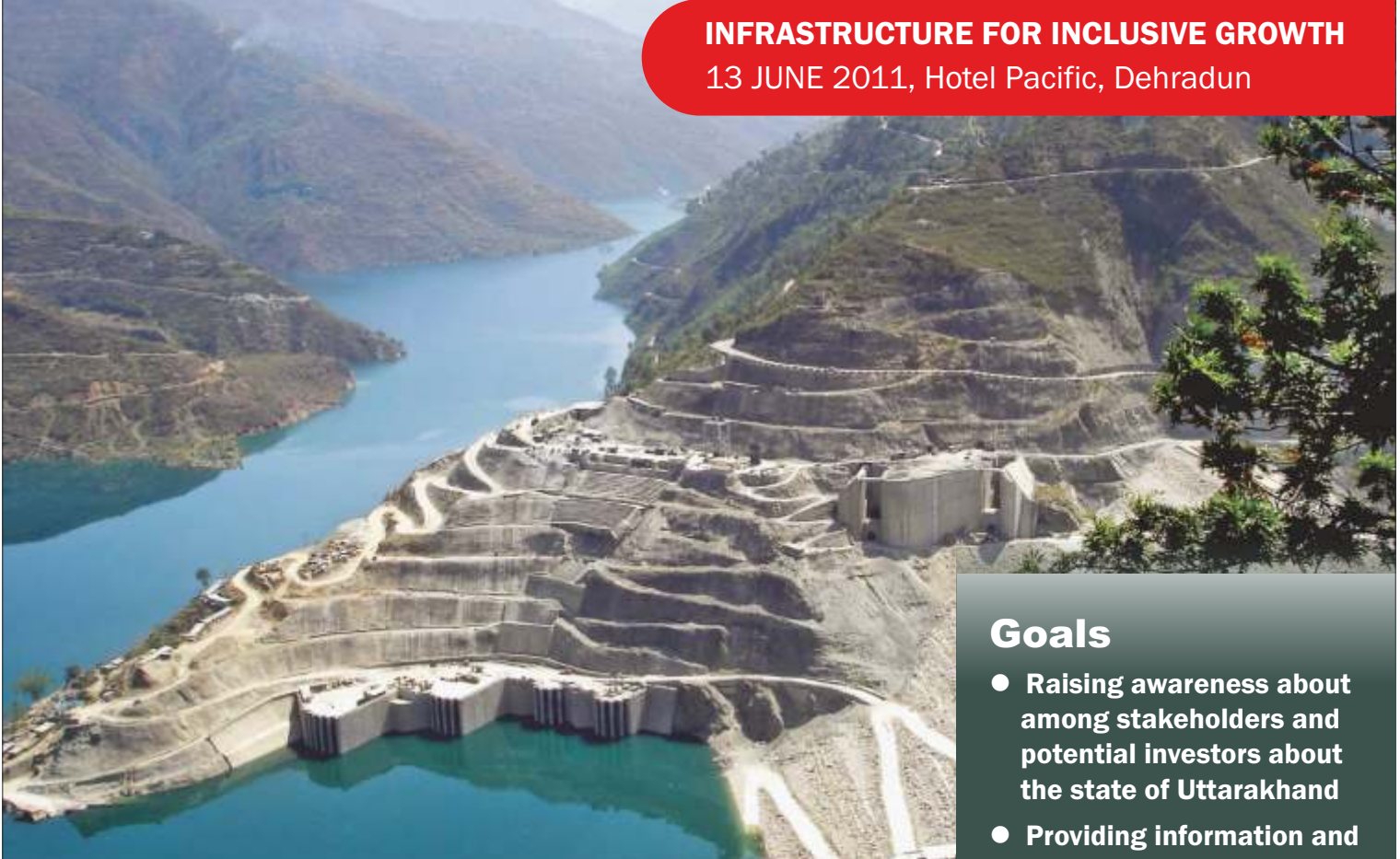

Invest in Uttarakhand

Formed in November 2000, Uttarakhand the 27th state of India is best known for its scenic surroundings, rich mineral deposits and rare bio-diversity which make it amenable for a variety of commercial opportunities in horticulture, floriculture and agriculture.

With good connectivity to the neighbouring states and to the capital, the state offers wide range of tax benefits and exemptions, financial assistance and promotional concessions. Infrastructure, such as roads, power, airports and rail connectivity, is well developed. Human resources are available in abundance, and in a short span Uttarakhand has emerged as a destination for investments across tourism, infrastructure and manufacturing sectors. Some of the government's initiatives and policy measures include extension of incentives to encourage flow of investments in varied sectors of its economy, single window approval mechanism, etc.

Some of the leading names from India's corporate world from the ICT industry, agro and food processing industry, FMCG sector and Engineering and allied industry have already made significant investments in Uttarakhand. The Tata Group, with an existing Nano car plant in Pantnagar, has already planned to invest in the state's power, housing, tourism and IT sectors.

Governor of Uttarakhand Margaret Alva has called for a 10-year action plan on the state's infrastructure. A focus on infrastructure challenges in the state should include electricity generation and tourism, and the state is poised to make concrete plans to boost the infrastructure to attract investments. Other projects such as a series of hydro power projects, decentralised watershed project, and a rail infrastructure plant, are set to come up.

PHDCCI and ASAPP Conferences, along with the Government of Uttarakhand are organizing a one-day **Uttarakhand State Infrastructure Summit**. The Summit will ensure a congregation of a large number of government agencies, industry practitioners, investors and independent experts, facilitating a meaningful interaction among the various stakeholders that will result in a set of recommendations for the state.
